RESOLUTION # 1 OF 2010
NYS and Delaware County Hiring Policy
FEBRUARY 8, 2010

WHEREAS, the State of New York is going broke, and has a hiring freeze in effect, and

WHEREAS, the County is facing rising costs and decreasing revenues, and has a hiring freeze in effect, and

WHEREAS, the taxpayers cannot afford any more increases, and could use a reduction in taxes, and

WHEREAS, these problems did not occur over night,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Delhi Town Board urge the State and County institute a hiring policy for the near future as follows;

A. When two positions are open, one position will be filled, and one position will be eliminated, whenever possible. This policy to be strictly enforced, with no appreciable increase in overtime, or contract work, until such time as budgets can be balanced, without new or increased taxes.

B. A moratorium on unfunded mandates until such time as they can reasonably become funded mandates, without raising taxes.

C. A moratorium on new interpretation of existing rules and regulations by State agencies, which result in increased costs to businesses and individual citizens.
